Description and Key Features


The Twelve Days of Christmas: Morning and Evening Thoughts on Immanuel—God with Us is a unique, attractively produced, high quality publication that is intended to help the hearts and minds of believers to focus on the wonder of the incarnation, as well as to encourage unbelievers to come in repentance and faith to Christ.

Produced in partnership between Great Writing (www.greatwriting.org) and SermonAudio.com, it is a beautifully produced, small-format book [4.25 x 7 inches] of 112 pages, and that is made up of twelve reflections on various aspects of the incarnation of the Lord Jesus Christ.

Each of the reflections is divided into morning and evening sections, is no more than four pages in length, and includes, at the conclusion of each morning and each evening reading, several bullet points titled “To Think About.” These draw lines of application from the text to the reader’s life, inviting prayer, changes of attitude and value, and transformation of life according to the truths that are explained.

Written in a spirit of grace and devotion, and in a way that will provoke further thinking and transformed living, the chapter titles are as follows:

The book is designed in such a way as to be shared with a variety of audiences. Because it is produced and sold on a prepublication basis, users are invited to choose (a) the cover they would like and (b) the Bible text they wish to use (from a choice of KJV, NKJV, and ESV texts). Depending on how many copies ordered (for example, in the use of the book for large-scale promotion such as in a book-of-the-month situation or for use in neighborhood evangelism), it is also possible to customize the back cover with details such as a church’s website information, service times, and phone numbers. Similarly, this can be undertaken on the inside of the book on a designated page, to include not only the kind of information on the back cover, but also a short message of encouragement from the pastor of the church or Christian organization.

Deep discounts are offered (up to 80% on scale), making this a highly affordable—excellent stewardship for any church’s budget.
